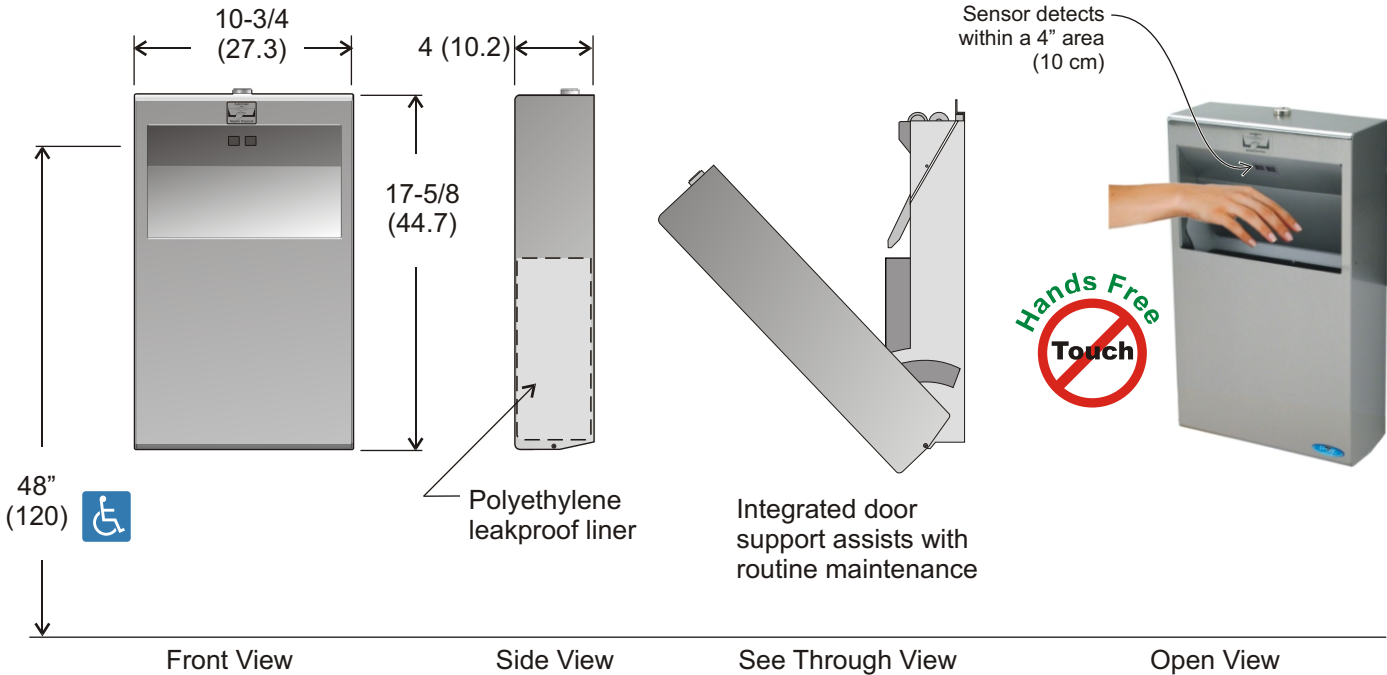

- Door is opened when hand is placed within 4" (10 cm) of sensor in door opening area and remains open for 5 seconds there after. Counterbalanced door swings freely in the event of depleted or missing batteries.
- Unit is powered by 4 "c" alkaline batteries (not included).
- Battery life is 10,000 cycles, or 2 years.
- Polyethylene leakproof liner capacity: 5.1 litres. (1.1 imp. gal.)
- All metal construction, stainless steel cover all design.
- 8.5 lbs. (4 kg).
- For unrestricted access, sensor area of unit to floor should not exceed 48" (120 cm). Mounting screws and instructions included.
